Instructions:

Divide into team of 3 to 4 students.

Players:

More advanced learners use pictures without sentences.

Players places 9 to 12 pictures on bingo board.

Players listen to caller. When a piece is called player confirms then turns over the piece.
The first student to turn over all pieces wins.
